25/04/14	<p>Christopher Bracken, 41 years from Jackson Street was found in an enclosed yard, JEWSONS, for an unlawful purpose – namely to steal</p> <p>Three month curfew and pay £145.00 costs/victims surcharge</p>
16/05/14	<p>Eric Jackson, 36 from St John Street in a street or public place, namely an alley just off Back Market Street, to the annoyance of residents or passengers committed an act of indecency by urinating within their view in contravention of a byelaw</p> <p>Pay a fine of £100.00 and £105.00 costs/victims surcharge</p>
25/04/14	<p>John Michael Pinner, 44 years from Lyon Close Jackson Street was found in an enclosed yard, JEWSONS, for an unlawful purpose – namely to steal. He was also in possession of cannabis and cocaine and later committed a Bail Act offence</p> <p>Ten week curfew and pay £145.00 costs/victims surcharge – drugs to be destroyed</p>
14/02/14	<p>Gareth Towey, 28 from Malvern Road dishonestly handled three power drills knowing or believing them to be stolen</p> <p>Ten weeks imprisonment – suspended for twelve months. Ten-week curfew to be complied with. Pay £85.00 costs and £80.00 victims surcharge</p>

02/06/14	<p>Craig Anthony Carney, 25 from Junction Lane was found in possession of amphetamine</p> <p>Twelve months Conditional discharge and pay £85.00 costs and £15.00 victims surcharge – drugs to be destroyed</p>
02/06/14	<p>Lee Cunningham, 25 from North Road stole a quantity of electrical cable belonging to BRITISH TELECOM</p> <p>Twelve months Conditional discharge and pay £100.00 costs/victims surcharge</p>
03/05/14	<p>Warren Marc Hall, 24 years from Whittle Street was found in possession of cocaine</p> <p>Four-week curfew and a supervision order with terms to be complied with. Pay £145.00 costs/victims surcharge – drugs to be destroyed</p>

09/05/14	<p>Jack Evers, 21 from Silkstone Street stole a quantity of loose change to the value of five pounds from a female</p> <p>Twelve months Conditional discharge and pay £100.00 costs/victims surcharge – with compensation of £5.00 payable to the female</p>
06/05/14	<p>David John Roberts, 41 years from Church Road, Haydock committed a common assault on a female. He also caused £70.00 worth of criminal damage to a mobile telephone belonging to the female and threatened to cause damage to a vehicle owned by her</p> <p>Carry out fifty hours of COMMUNITY PAYBACK work within twelve months. Pay compensation to the female of £70.00 and £145.00 cost/victims surcharge</p>
17/11/13	<p>Neil Jackson, 45 from the Crewe area committed a common assault on a male on Dentons Green Lane</p> <p>Twenty-six weeks imprisonment – suspended for twenty-four months. Four-week curfew. To carry out three hundred hours of COMMUNITY PAYBACK work within twelve months. Pay £50.00 victims surcharge and £500.00 compensation to the male assaulted. Also to comply with the terms of a restraining order to prevent further contact with the male</p>
30/03/14	<p>Francis John Scullion, 48 years from Lascelles Street drove a Ford Transit van on that street with excess alcohol in his body</p> <p>Twelve months supervision and carry out one hundred and twenty hours of COMMUNITY PAYBACK work. Pay £145.00 costs/victims surcharge and disqualified from driving for twenty-eight months</p>
