12/06/14	<p>James Michael George Hull, 32 years from Hilbrae Avenue stole £5.00 worth of cheese from the ASDA store</p> <p>Twelve months Conditional discharge. Ordered to pay compensation of £5.00 to the store manager with a further £100.00 costs/victims surcharge</p>
13/06/14	<p>Kevin Michael Woods, 53 years from Scholes Lane drove a motor vehicle on Scholes Lane with excess alcohol in his body</p> <p>Pay £250.00 fine and £110.00 costs/victims surcharge and disqualified from driving for sixteen months</p>
