26/09/14	<p>Michael Anthony Crosby, 24 years from Park Road committed a common assault on a female. He also made threats to kill the female. On the same date he caused criminal damage to the females property amounting to £300.00 in value</p> <p>Twelve weeks imprisonment – forthwith and pay £80.00 victims surcharge</p>
06/02/13	<p>Liam Mathew Morris, 20 of Kelbrook Close committed an assault on another male causing actual bodily harm – Section 47 of the Offences Against the Person Act 1861</p> <p>Comply with a Community order, to include the completion of two hundred and fifty hours of COMMUNITY PAYBACK work. Pay £250.00 compensation and £60.00 victims surcharge</p>
18/02/14	<p>Zak Andrew Mortimer, 34 years from the Bolton Area was found in possession of cannabis</p> <p>Pay £100.00 fine and £105.00 costs/victims surcharge – drugs to be destroyed</p>
