03/08/14	<p>Paul Fieldhouse, 29 years from Phoenix Brow stole £38.88 worth of meats from the CO-OP store on Chain Lane</p> <p>Pay compensation in the full amount to the store manager with £85.00 costs</p>
11/10/14	<p>Darren Lee Unsworth, 37 from the Garswood area committed a common assault on a female</p> <p>Eighteen months Conditional discharge and pay £100.00 costs/victims surcharge</p>
19/04/14	<p>Joanne Casey, 29 years from Billington Avenue knowingly permitted or suffered to take place on the premises – 157 Billington Avenue - the production of a controlled drug namely cannabis</p> <p>Pay £400.00 fine and £125.00 costs/victims surcharge – drugs to be destroyed</p>
17/08/14	<p>David Anthony Gordon, 41 years from Rye Close stole a wallet containing £200.00 at Fonezone on Church Street</p> <p>Eighteen months Conditional discharge, pay £300.00 compensation and £100.00 costs/victims surcharge</p>
