NUISANCE GRASSLAND FIRES

Don't let them get away with it!

- It puts people's lives at risk, causes damage to homes, businesses, community facilities & impacts on wildlife & the environment.
- It prevents the fire service from attending to other emergencies which could endanger lives elsewhere.
- It's mindless criminal damage.

Tell us:

- **Who:** If you know who is responsible tell the police, so they can act on your information & bring those responsible to justice.
- **When:** The date & whether you witnessed the offence.
- **Where:** Parks, grassland, open spaces, wheelie bins, land near homes & businesses & wasteland.

You can help by ensuring you don't have combustible waste stored next to the walls of your home, storing your wheelie bin away until collection day & by sharing any home CCTV footage, or vehicle dash cam footage of deliberate fire setters caught in action with the police on: **101**.

Call **999** if the offence is in action so that relevant Emergency Service can respond.
